

LHS School Score Summary for 2014

- 534 students were enrolled in 1 or more AP courses
- 95% of enrolled AP students took at least 1 AP exam (507 out of 534 AP students)
- AP students took **92.3%** of the exams for which they were eligible (1,178 exams out of a possible 1,276)
- The number of AP test takers increased by **1%** since 2013
- The number of exams that were taken has increased by **9%** since 2013
- **93.9%** of the students scored 3 or higher in 2014
- As the number of students enrolled in AP has steadily increased, LHS students have been consistent with a score of 3 or higher:
 - 2009 92.8%
 - 2010 94.5%
 - 2011 96.1%
 - 2012 95.5%
 - 2013 96.6%
 - 2014 93.9%
- 1,083 of the 1,178 exams taken resulted in a score of **3 or higher**
- 866 of the 1,178 exams taken resulted in a score of 4 or higher
