2. What is the fashion show all about?

Every Fashion Show participant receives a Sash and Flag from the country they represent. The fashion show is conducted grade-wise, your child will not be walking alone, he/she will be with all the other friends in their grade, irrespective of which country they represent. There will be one rehearsal during the week days between 6 & 7pm where the sashes and flags will be handed out.
