CLASS OF 2023: **THE POST-SECONDARY APPLICATION PROCESS**

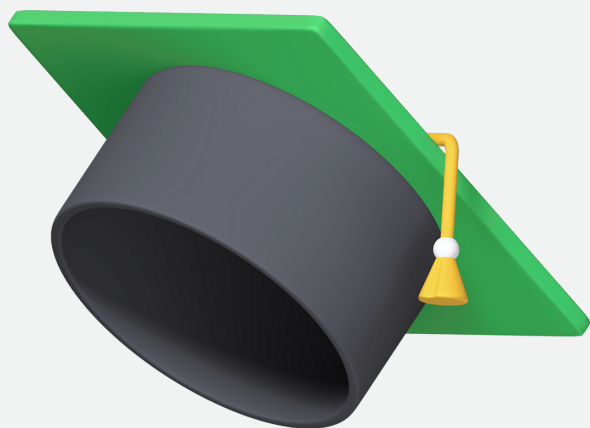
When: Thursday, April 7 (7:00-8:00 p.m.)

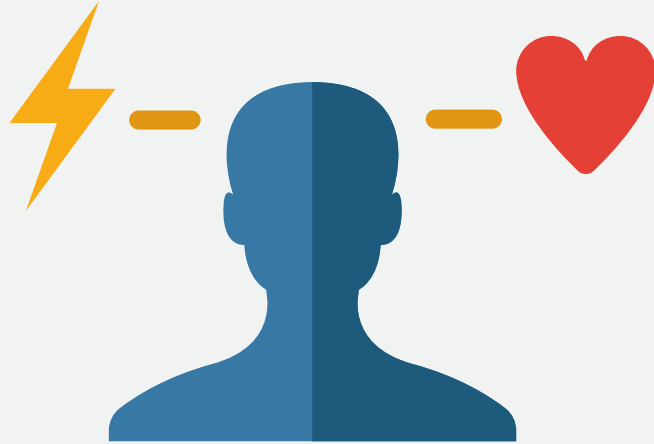
This program is for the parents of English Language Learners in our ELL program (grades K-12). Families will learn strategies to support learning at home.
