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Charles Raphael to be Appointed as Assistant Principal at HMS

Prior to being appointed as the district's Supervisor of Social Studies (7-12), Mr. Raphael was a social studies teacher at LHS for nine years.

Charles Raphael, who has served as the 7-12 Social Studies Supervisor for the past five years, will be making the transition to the assistant principal role starting this summer. His extensive knowledge and expertise in pedagogy and the background work that he has done within the field of diversity, equity, and inclusion will assist us in expanding upon the work that we have been doing in these areas over the past few years. Mr. Raphael's patient and empathetic approach towards how he works with children will also help to ensure that he will serve as a
