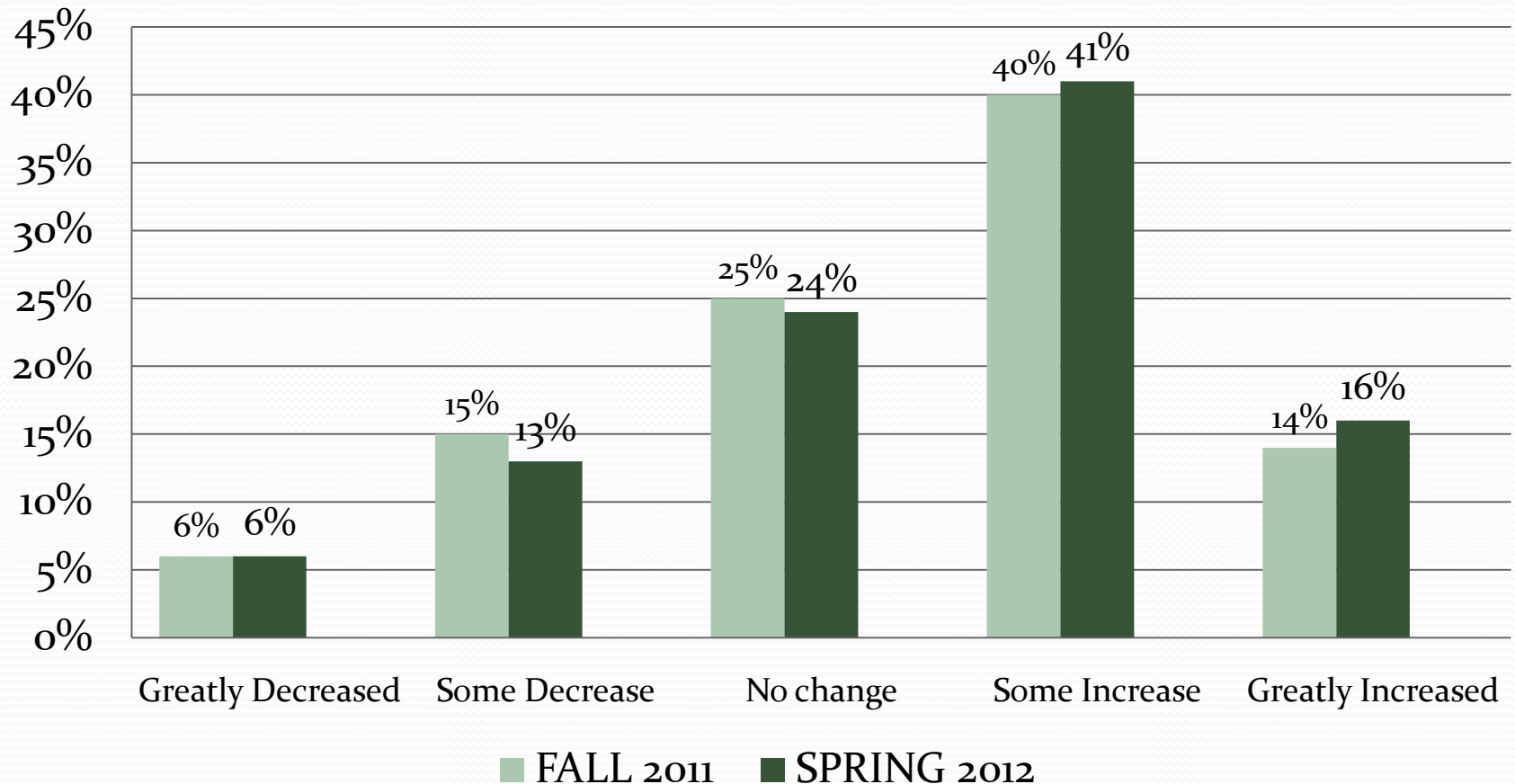

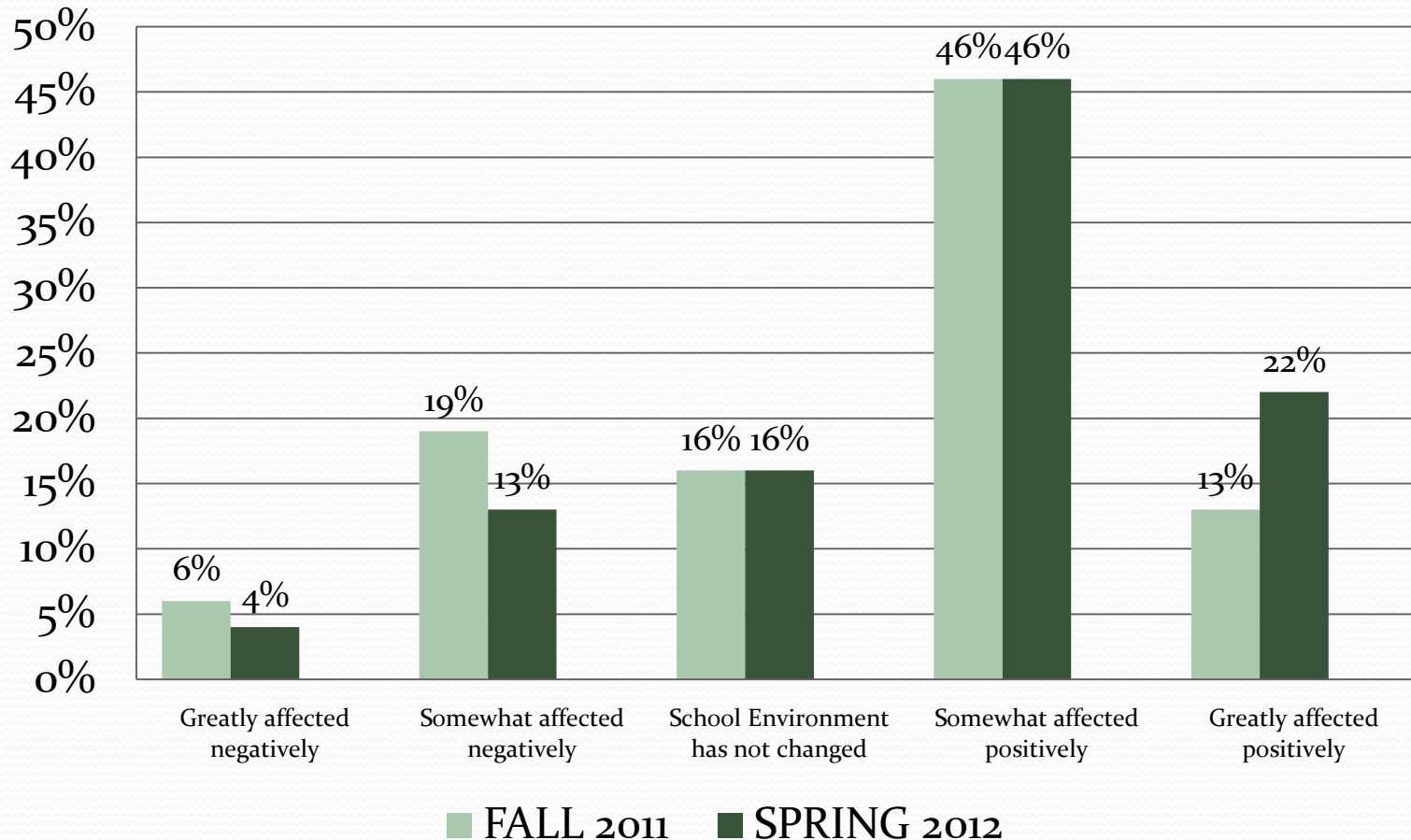

How has the rotating drop schedule impacted the manageability of your workload in comparison to last school year?



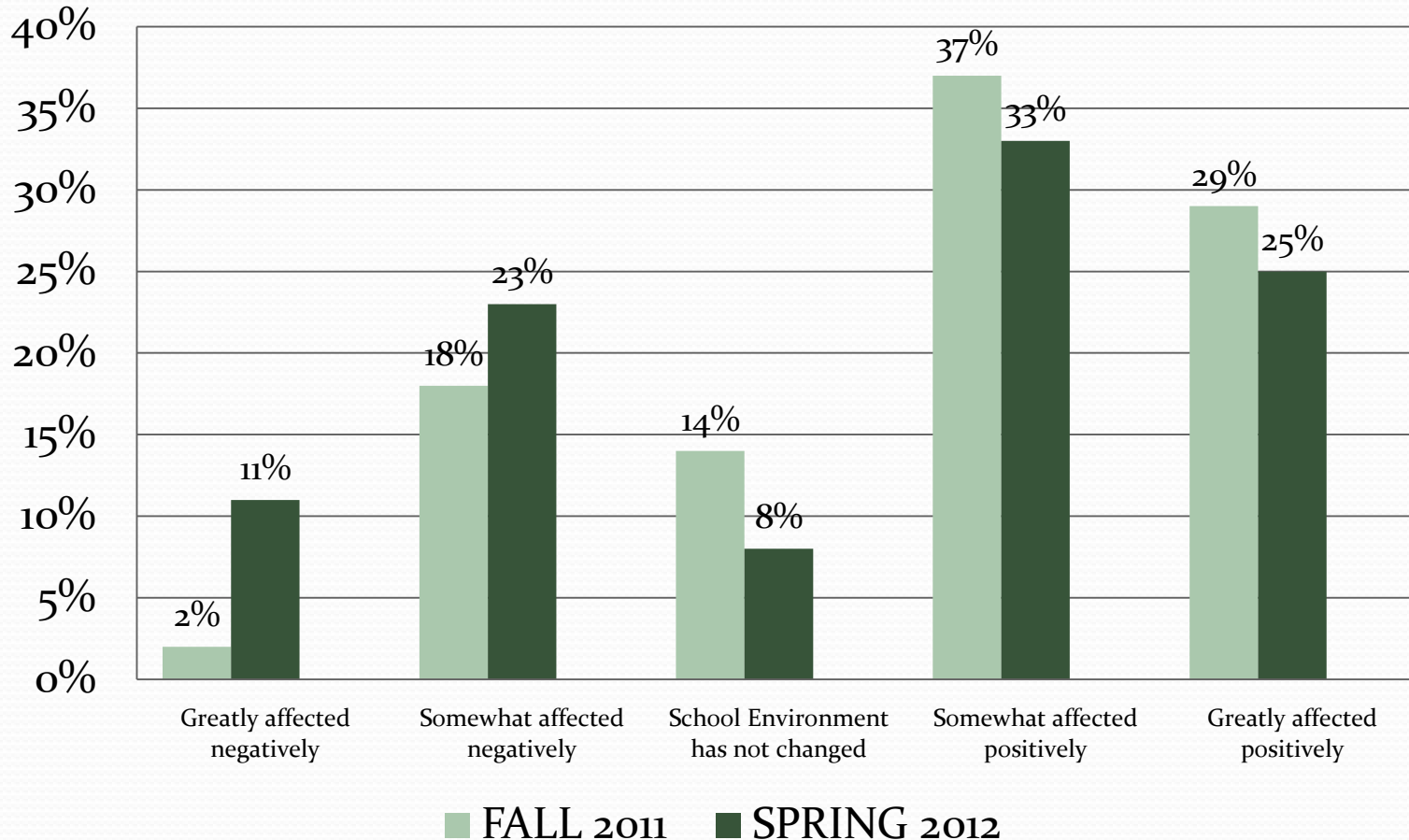
STUDENTS SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

How has the rotating drop schedule affected your daily school environment in comparison to last school year?



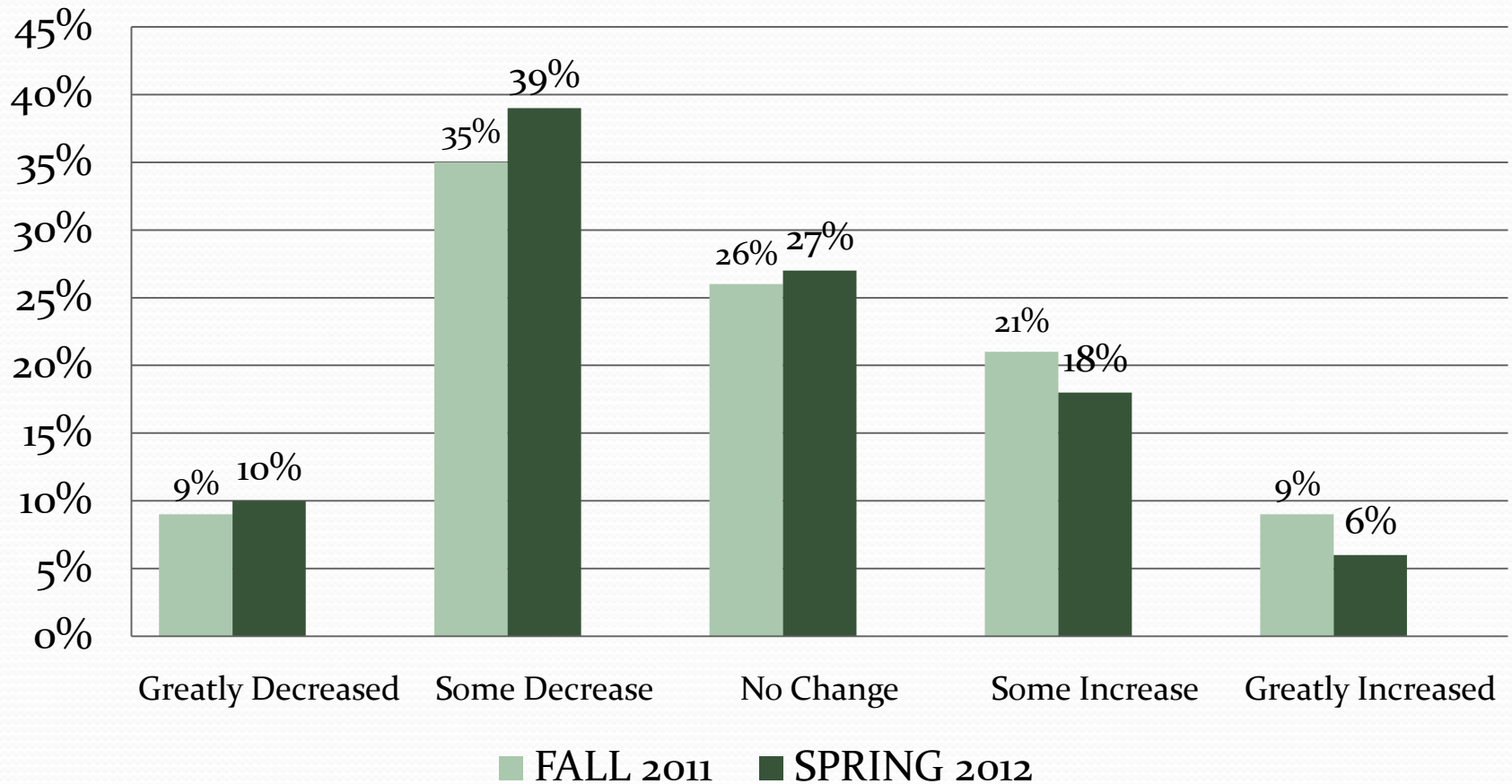
STAFF WORK ENVIRONMENT

How has the rotating drop schedule affected your daily work environment in comparison to last school year?



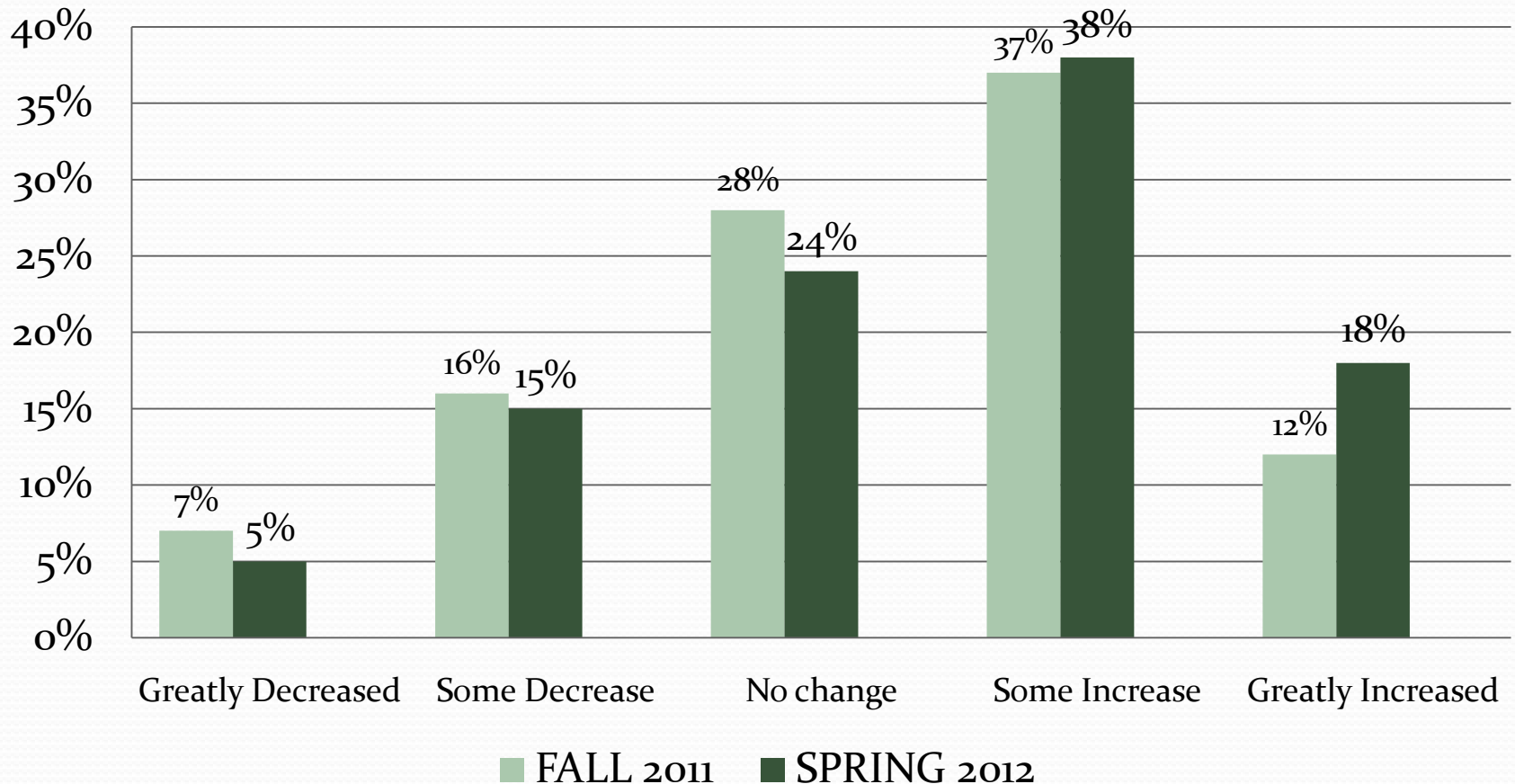
STUDENT HOMEWORK

How has the rotating drop schedule impacted the amount of homework you have on average per night in comparison to last school year?



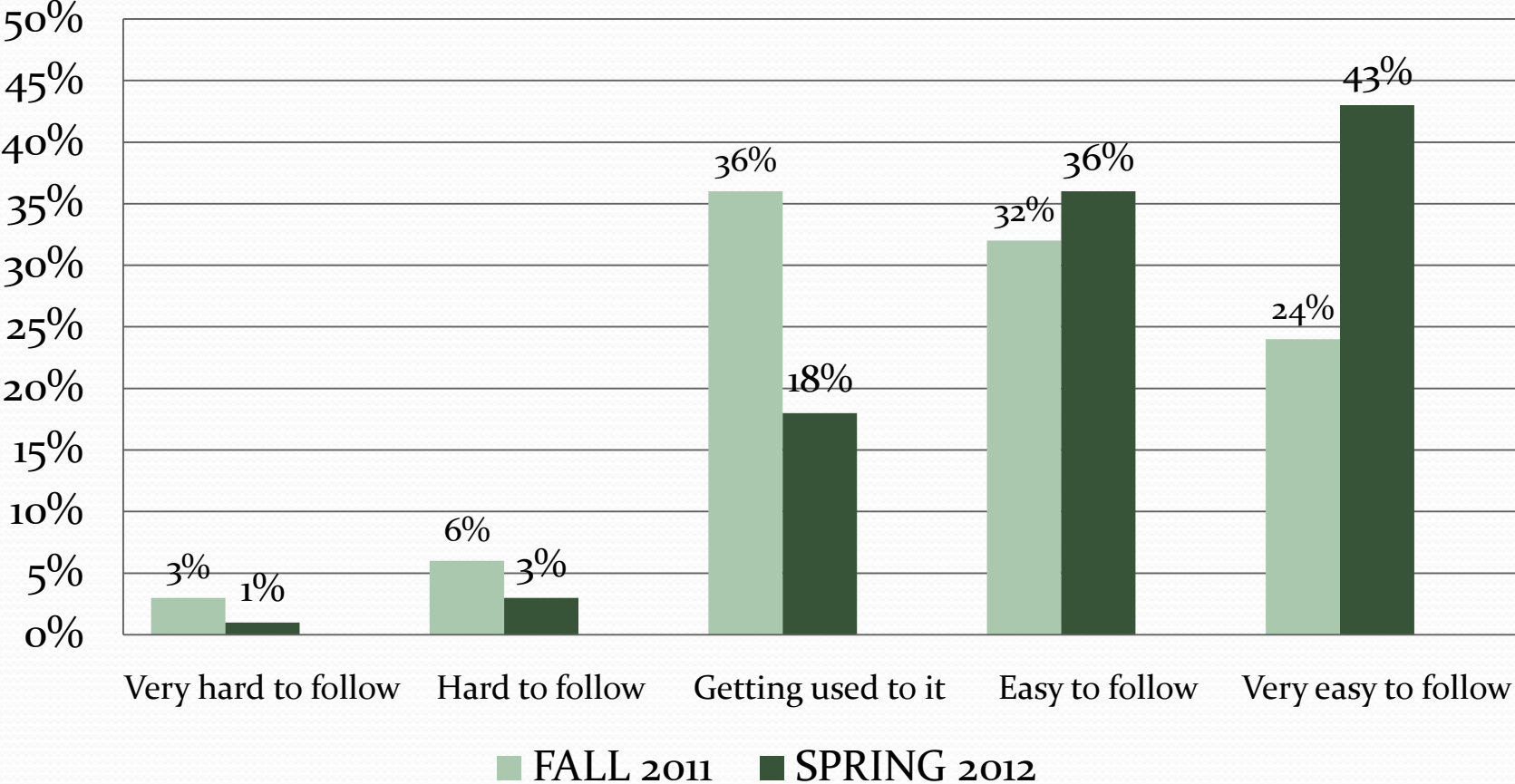
STUDENT HOMEWORK MANAGEABILITY

How has the rotating drop schedule impacted the manageability of homework you have in comparison to last school year?



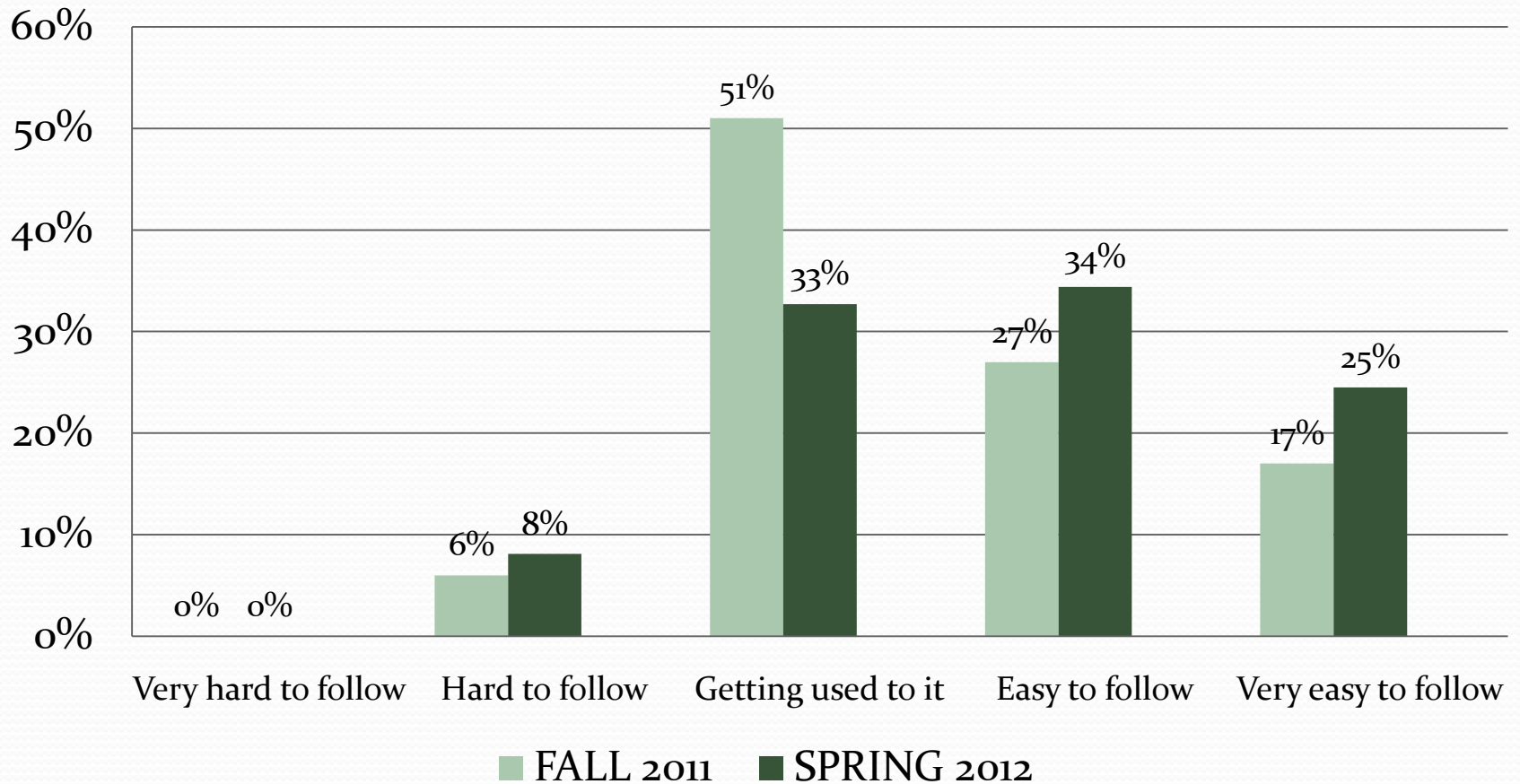

How easy is it to follow your rotating drop schedule?



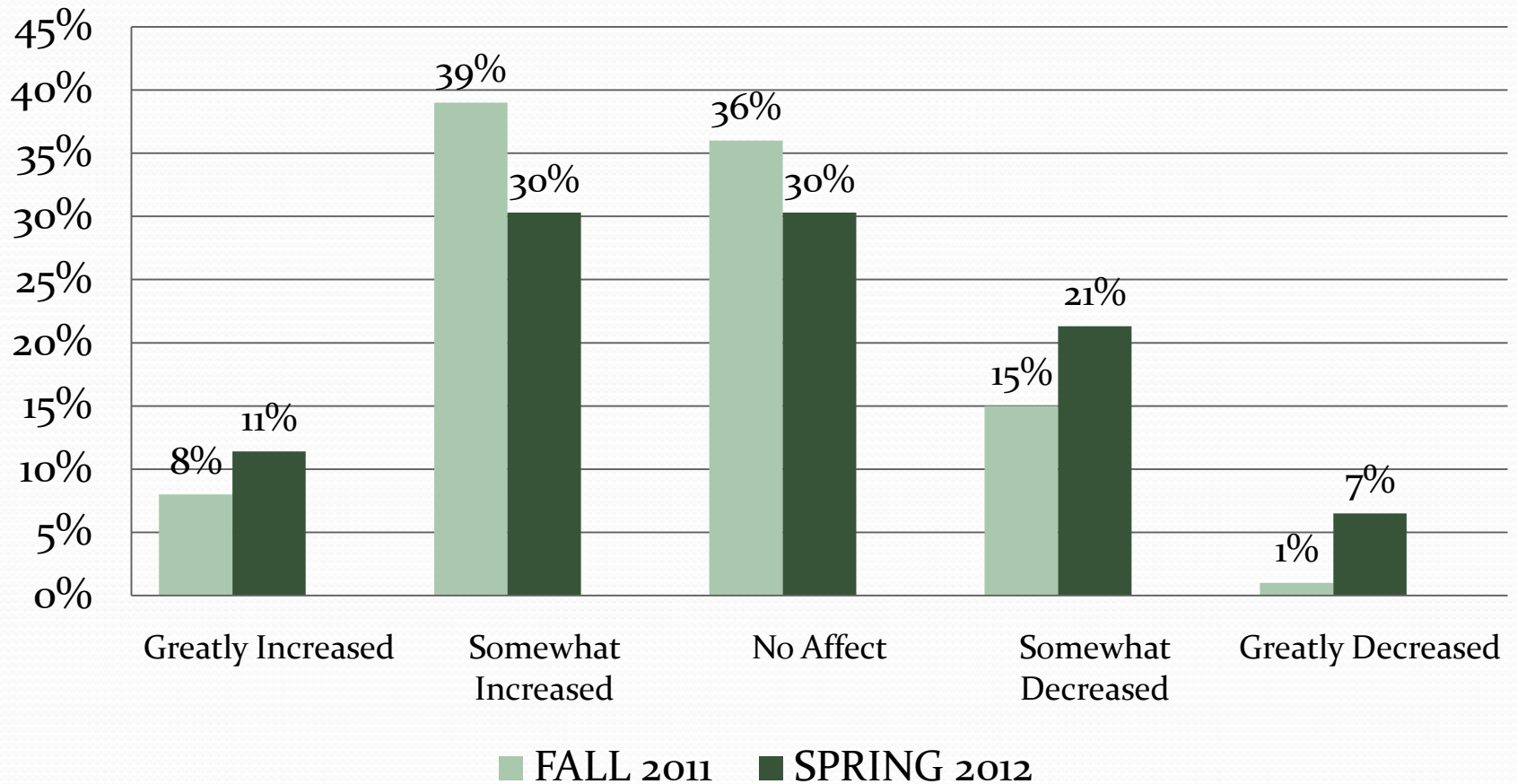

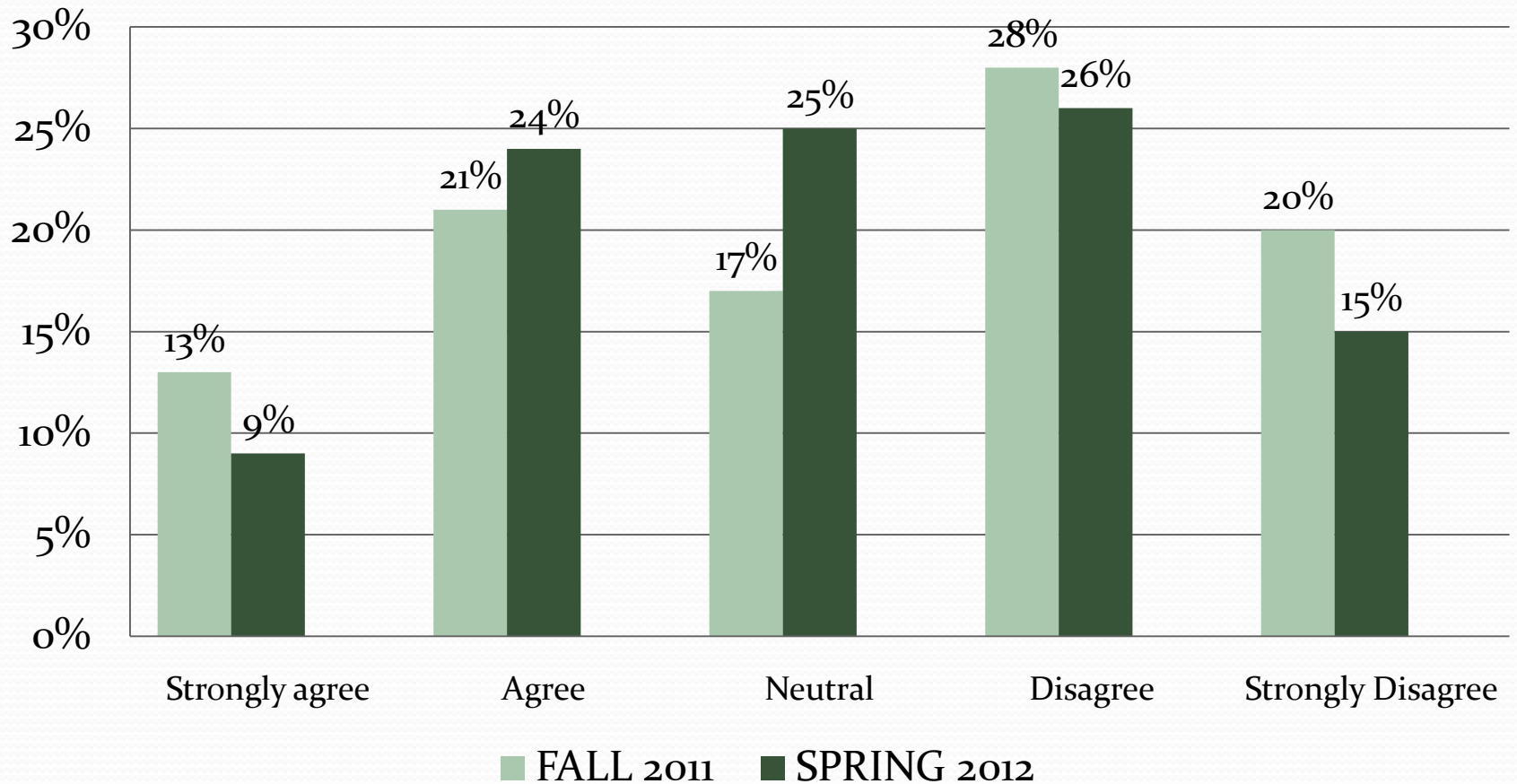
STAFF ON STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

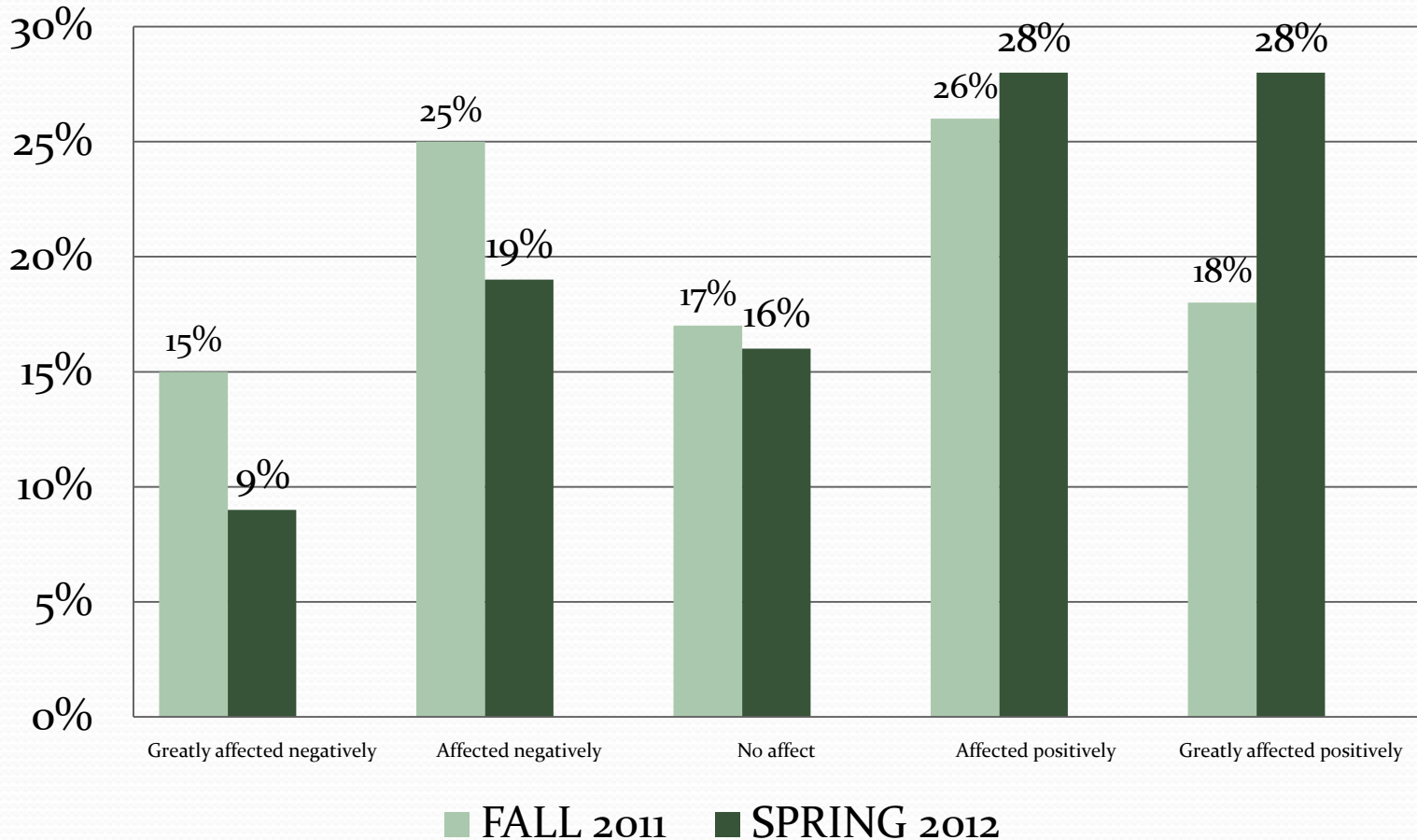

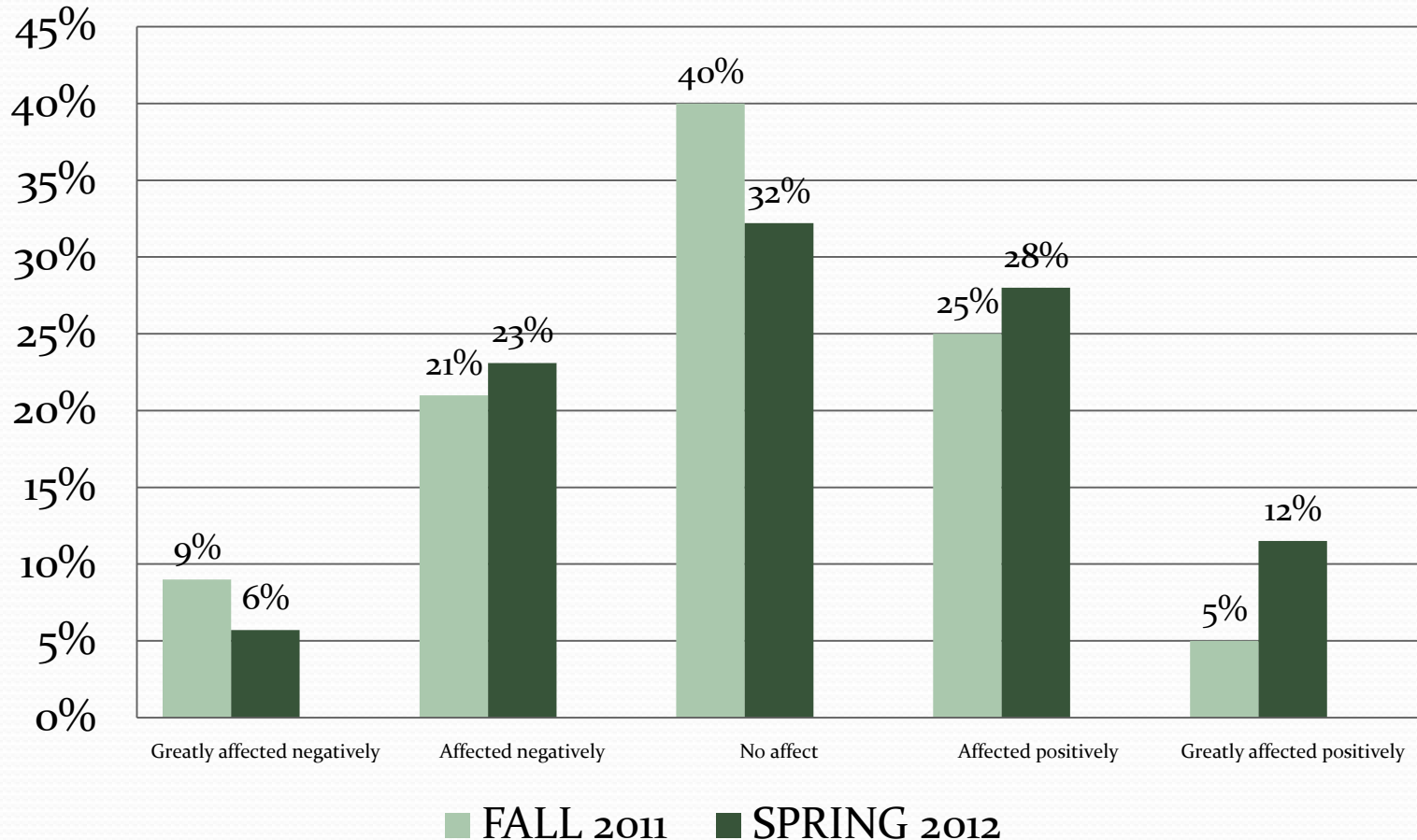

How has the unit lunch affected your overall lunch experience in comparison to last school year?



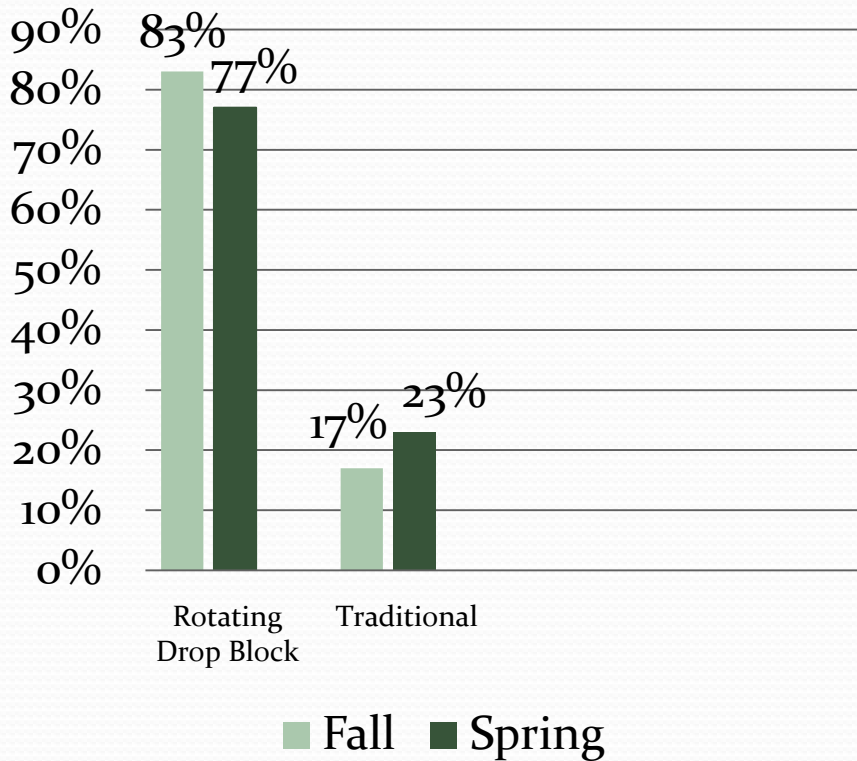
