Senators Arends, Coleman, Kim, Rosenstark, Zhuang introduce the following bill

A BILL

Preamble -

This bill will eliminate National Standardized Testing from all public schools in the United States.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

Sec. 1-

This bill will ensure that no public school student will have to part take a National Standardized Test. The bill will require the State Department of Education to notify the U.S. Department of Education of any public school districts.

Sec. 2-

National testing is defined as testing that all students have to take and they all take the same test.

Sec 3.

Private schools are exempted from the bill.

Sec.4-

This law will be implemented by the United States Department of Education and enforced by the local board of education.

Sec.5-

The Funding will come from the United States Department of Education. The money will also come from the penalty of this bill --- a more than \$10,000 and less than \$13,000 fine, which will be paid to the United States Department of Education to enforce this bill.

Sec.6-

The penalty will be that if a school district issues a standardized test, they will be fined no more than \$13,000 and no less than \$10,000. For a second violation the fine will double.

Sec.7-

The law will take effect in the 2016-2017 school year.
