Mrs. Mullen – Grade 4

In Mrs. Mullen's class, the students learned about Ruby Bridges. Ruby is an American activist known for being the first black child to desegregate the all-white William Frantz Elementary School in Louisiana during the New Orleans school desegregation crisis in 1960. Ruby is a hero because her bravery paved the way for continued Civil Rights action.

Our class participated in a read aloud biography about Ruby Bridges, independently read articles and watched a video of her historic day.

We discussed why she was a hero, and each individual student created a google drawing that highlighted Ruby's achievement and character traits she lives by.
