

### **Community Meetings**

Throughout the school year MPE students will participate in "Community Meetings". Community groups are comprised of students in grades K-5 and a teacher. Students meet to address topics related to New Jersey's social and emotional learning competencies; self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, responsible decision-making, and relationship skills. Relevant books are read, skills are practiced, discussions take place, and activities are completed to reinforce these topics. Students truly look forward to their time spent in community meetings and it is amazing to watch our older students take on a leadership role with our younger students! Lesson topics and follow-up questions will be included in our newsletters throughout the school year!

MPE students participated in their first Community Meeting during the month of October! Students read the book I am Human: A Book of Empathy by Susan Verde. This book helped students feel more connected to one another by describing the similarities we all have. For example, we are all learning, have feelings, make mistakes, enjoy when others are kind, find joy in friendships, and want forgiveness. Students then brainstormed what characteristics they have that makes them human. Students described themselves as, "Helpful, Friendly, Determined, Confident, Athletic, Kind, Thoughtful, Brave, etc." We encourage you to discuss this topic with your children at home.

#### Walk-A-Thon




