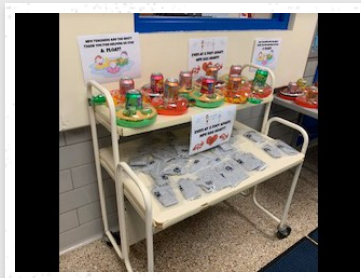
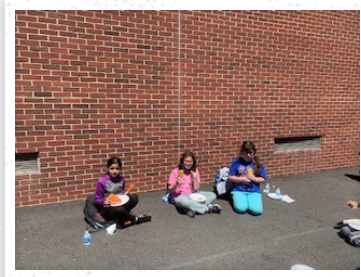
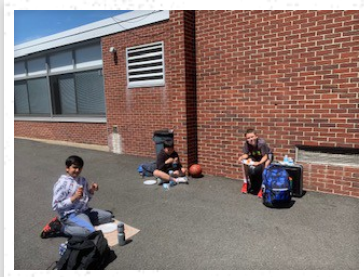

### **Social Distancing and Mask Protocols**
