# Monday, May 10th - Full Day, In Person Instruction Begins!!! IMPORTANT INFORMATION

We are planning for our next pivot for full-day in-person instruction. If this pivot could potentially change your child's status from remote to in-person, please contact the MPE office **BY MAY 3, 2021** to determine if space is available. Next week, we will send home a presentation with more detailed information regarding this final pivot. Additionally, we will host a webinar on May 6 at 7 pm as we know you may have questions.

**Arriva**l will remain the same. Please be sure your child is ready to exit the car when the staff member opens the car door. Arrival will take place from **8:00 - 8:15 a.m**. Doors will open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 8:15 a.m. Students arriving after 8:15 a.m. will be considered tardy and parents will need to bring their child to the front door and ring the bell. Remote students should be online with their teachers by 8:15 a.m. Teachers will send out information about their daily schedule the week of May 3rd.

**Dismissal** will be slightly staggered to help with the social distancing. Students will be walked out with the teacher or staff member in a socially distanced manner. Students will be released to guardians once the teacher has made eye contact. Bus students will be walked to the bus by a staff member.

**Lunch and Recess**: Each class will have a lunch and recess period. More information about procedures will be sent home next week. During recess, students will wear masks as they play on the playgrounds, fields, blacktop, and gaga pit. Classes will be assigned designated places to have lunch and recess. On inclement weather days, students will have lunch indoors. At this time, students must remain six feet apart when unmasked and eating. Therefore, we will maximize the use of the large spaces. Please send in a towel each day unless your child's teacher indicates otherwise. Parents will be able to order cold lunches through Aramark's Food Service. Additional information is forthcoming.

**Snack:** Some classes will still have a snack as scheduled by the classroom teachers. We encourage you to send a healthy, hearty snack to sustain your child until dismissal. Teachers will try to take students outside for snack as often as possible. Please send your child in with a beach towel so they can comfortably sit on the blacktop, socially distanced. More information will be provided next week.



## Very Important Reminders
