Thoughtfully decorated placemats are a lovely extra to bring to meal recipients, as are cards, or pictures. If you're able to laminate the placemats, all the better! Although this is not required. You can also make birthday cards or pictures to be included in families' meals as a way to bring additional smiles to their faces! Pictures, cards, and placemats can be delivered to MPE when school reopens to be sent to Meals on Wheels.

Donate canned or non-perishable food to Livingston Neighbors Helping Neighbors. Food donations can be dropped off at Livingston's Town Hall.

Make cards for your local sanitation workers, postal workers, delivery workers, or first responders.

Saying thank you to our local workers is a kind way to give back to your community. Make sure to have an adult help you deliver your cards.

Donate prepared food to Newark, NJ soup kitchens through Livingston Neighbors Helping Neighbors. While preparing food- masks and gloves must be worn. Prepared foods such as trays of mac- ncheese or baked ziti should be covered with foil (fresh or frozen). Prepared sandwiches such as peanut butter & jelly can be placed in ziplock sandwich bags.

Zones of Regulation

Teachers are using common language to teach our students about the Zones of Regulation to talk about emotions. Each color represents a different set of emotions; Blue- Sad, Tired, Bored, Green-Happy, Calm, Focused, Ready to Learn, Yellow- Frustrated, Silly, Nervous, Excited, Red- Mad, Angry, Out of Control. Students learn to identify which zone they are in as well as strategies to help them get from the Blue, Yellow, and Red Zones back to Green so they are ready to learn! Strategies may include doing jumping jacks, taking deep breaths, drawing, listening to music, etc.
