#### MPE SCHOOL FAIR - THURSDAY, JUNE 10

Here comes the day all our kids have been waiting for... the MPE SCHOOL FAIR!

When: THURSDAY, JUNE 10 from dismissal till 5pm

**Who:** MPE students and their supervising adult only. Due to COVID safety procedures no siblings are allowed to participate who are not students at MPE.

\*There is currently a limit of 500 attendees total unless COVID restrictions are lifted on May 19th.

**Supervision:** The school fair is NOT a drop off event and MPE Students must be supervised by an adult!

**COVID SAFETY:** If any person attending the Fair tests COVID positive within 48 hours of this event, any child(ren) and/or adult who attended with them or who were closer than 6 feet apart for more than 15min at the event will be subject to contact tracing and potential quarantine procedures. Masks must be worn at all times except when eating. When eating, all non family members must be seated at least 6 feet apart.

**Cost:** \$10 per student. This fee includes a wristband for admission to the fair, use of all inflatables and games.

Activities: Unlike prior years this is a "Dry" event. No bathing suits. There will be giant inflatable slides and spin wheel games that allow children to remain at least 6ft apart, DJ, chalk art, crafts, a Bubble guy and other surprises.

**Food:** All water and food must be purchased separately via private Food Trucks that will be available during the Fair at the front of MPE. Trucks will include a Pizza Truck, a Burger/Hotdog/Fries/Onion rings truck and a Novelty Ice Cream Truck. Attendees must wear their mask and be 6 feet apart in line.

Deadline: Click <u>HERE</u> to register by JUNE 4th! NO Walk-ins will be allowed. Students must be preregistered and parents must agree to Safety Protocol.
