We are excited to share with you information about our third annual Course Preview Day.

On Tuesday, January 8, 2019, freshmen, sophomores, and juniors will have the opportunity to gain valuable information about courses they are interested in taking during the 2019-2020 school year before scheduling begins in February. During the program, students will meet with teachers of elective, CP, Honors, and AP courses who will give an overview of their course, outline course expectations, and provide examples of class assignments and student work. Through these informative sessions, students will gain insight into courses of interest to them, which will help them make informed decisions for their scheduling choices.

On Course Preview Day, underclassmen will report to their homerooms at the regular time, by 7:50 a.m. From there, they will proceed to four 20-minute sessions of their choosing scheduled at the following times:
