THE SEARCH PROCESS

- → As students examine prospective colleges, what should they be looking for?
- → Can students rely on the "rating" and "ranking" systems that many magazines use to evaluate colleges?
- → How can students with learning disabilities find out about colleges that offer special programs?

THE SEARCH PROCESS

- → How do colleges view consistency with Honors and AP selections from year to year?
- → Can you share any words of wisdom for students regarding course selection and its impact on college plans?
- → What does it mean when admissions recalculates weighted grades?

THE ADMISSIONS PROCESS

- → Is there any way to learn in advance just how colleges make their admissions decisions?
- → Do you really only look at the highest scores when superscoring? What if my score on a particular section went down?

- → If a student is considering transferring in the future, what steps should they take now?
