School and Community Profile 2019 - 2020



Livingston High School is a comprehensive, public high school that provides programs to meet the diverse needs of approximately 1,950 students enrolled in grades 9-12. The school calendar incorporates two semesters, and the school runs on a Rotating Drop Schedule, which creates more time for staff to collaborate and develop instructional goals on cross-curricular levels. There are 56-minute class periods on a rotation and 81-minute lab periods that meet once every four days. All students pursue an appropriate academic program encouraging active involvement in learning. The academic program is augmented by a wide range of elective courses and an alternative high school program to help guarantee the success of all students. Approximately 97% of the Class of 2019 attended a post-secondary institution (90% attended a four-year institution, 7% attended a two-year institution, and 2% are employed, active in our military or participating in a gap year program). At Livingston High School, 74% of the professionals hold master's degrees and 4.5% of the staff have received their doctorates. Livingston High School provides extensive staff development opportunities for all staff members. The faculty at Livingston High School believes in lifelong learning; this is modeled through their participation in educational opportunities. They have been recognized by professional organizations with honors and awards. Livingston High School has completed a series of building improvements including a renovated media center. LHS maintains updated science laboratories, fine arts studios, a robotics and technology wing, an athletic complex featuring a state-of-the-art fitness and wellness center, a renovated performing arts center, and major classroom and technology renovations.

Livingston Township is a suburban, residential community located approximately 20 miles from New York City. A large percentage of community members hold a college degree. The residents of Livingston support educational excellence and have a strong belief in the importance of quality education. Livingston Township has made and continues to expand its support of the arts, volunteerism, multiple hospitals and improvement of parks and recreational facilities.
