LHS ACADEMICS & CURRICULUM

All students pursue a challenging and appropriate academic program, encouraging active involvement in learning. The academic program is augmented by a wide range of elective courses and an alternative high school program to help guarantee the success of all students.

- Students follow a semester calendar, and on a Rotating Drop Schedule, which creates more time for staff to collaborate and develop instructional goals on cross-curricular levels.
- There are 55-minute class periods on a rotation and 80-minute lab periods that meet once every four days.
- All students pursue a challenging and appropriate academic program encouraging active involvement in learning.

The school's curriculum offers a vast array of Advanced Placement, Honors, College Preparatory, and elective courses across multiple disciplines. The <u>LHS</u> <u>Course Guide</u> contains descriptions of all course offerings.
