- 5) Ogni articolo vale 5 punti (quindi 25 punti in totale).
- 6) Staple each article and summary + vocabulary list together

#### II. Parlare

Using **photos** that you (or your family/friends) either took or that you found on the internet to reflect your actions, you must create a project talking about where you went, what you did and your experiences **this summer, 2022**. You may remember I did one for you the first day of Italian 3. I'll do another the first day in September. Your presentation must include:

- 1) 10 slides (+1 general title slide) + at least 2 or more pictures/images per slide.
- 2) AT LEAST **3 sentences per slide** that reflect the pictures you're talking about. Sentences should NOT BE WRITTEN on slide... only SPOKEN.
- 3) **Passato prossimo/imperfetto** with a **VARIETY of verbs** (use different ones in entire presentation) and use of BOTH ESSERE and AVERE in the passato prossimo. Make sure you have your verb forms correct and use them properly!

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- 4) A title for your project and a **title/theme for each slide** (in italiano!). Nothing else written... only SPOKEN. Please don't write sentences on the slides.
- 5) No reading off note cards (you may have a note card only as a reminder)
- 6) Well-presented visually with interesting and well-organized slides. Be creative!
- 7) This will be due Tuesday, Sep. 6... not the day we get back.

Contenuto	You include at least 10 slides and appropriate photos, a title for each slide, summer-oriented words and 2 sentences in the pictures in your presentation. You use a good variety of verbs. Grammatica	Your use of passato prossimo and imperetto is accurate using correct verbs and essere or avere. Sentences also are completely or almost completely grammatically correct.	Use of passato prossimo is somewhat accurate but you make 3 or more errors in its use. Sentences are somewhat correct but 3 or more grammatical errors.	Use of passato prossimo has 6 or more serious errors. Sentences have many other grammatical errors that inhibit comprehension
Parlare	Italian is very fluent, showing excellent pace and fluency. Your pronunciation is excellent, and you make very few to no mistakes.	Italian is good but with some noticeable errors. Pronunciation is generally good but you mispronounce 4 or more words or use them improperly. Some English	There are many serious pronunciation errors in your speaking that inhibit comprehensibility. You use a lot of English.
Presentazione	Your eye contact to the class and teacher is excellent. You barely use your note card or not at all. You allude to photos by pointing to and indicating what is and is happening in each photo.	You do some reading from your notecard. Good eye contact but some looking at note card and into space. You point to/indicate things in photos but not consistently enough.	You read a lot to most all of your presentation from your notecard. Very little eye contact with audience/teacher. Little to no indication of photos.
Slide creatività	Presentation is very well-organized and visually interesting and attractive with creative and appropriate pictures, transitions and titles.	Presentation is somewhat well-organized and visually attractive, showing evidence of some creativity and time spent creating it.	Presentation is not at all interesting, poorly organized, lacking titles and showing little evidence of creativity and time spent.
