The purpose of this homework is to help you retain the language that you have acquired this past school year (and perhaps acquire more!). You have approximately 10 weeks.

Journal: Each Part 1- JOURNAL

The journal works best if you do one entry per week. Below are some suggestions that you may use, or you may come up with your own themes. Do your best **WITHOUT** using a translator or dictionary. If you need to know a word, **do NOT** translate the entire sentences. You may look up individual words on **wordreference.com**.

Each week, write a one paragraph entry in French. Each paragraph should be <u>7-8 sentences</u> long. You can vary your themes. Below are some suggestions. You may think of others topics, and you may expand these thoughts.

Week 1: Describe yourself and your family. What do they look like? What does each person like and dislike?

Week 2: Talk about what you ordered while dining out. What was the restaurant like, did you like the service? Will you recommend it to someone else? Anything unique you can tell about the place?

Week 3: Talk about things you did last week, activities, events. Describe what happened. Any museums? Camping? Tell about something silly or scary that happened.

Week 4: Talk about something that **happened** in the news. (Describe it, a heroic event, a natural disaster or anything you found interesting.) What **is happening now** in the news?

Week 5: Describe a shopping trip. Where **did you go**? What **did you buy**? Describe something funny that **happened**. What errands **did you do**?

Week 6: Describe a party you **are going to** plan in the future. What is the occasion? What will the date be? What things will you do?

Week 7: Tell about a movie you saw. Did you like it? Why?

Week 8: Talk about your favorite music group. What are they like? What kind of music.

Week 9: Describe your two best friends. What are their likes/dislikes? What things do you guys enjoy doing together?

Week 10: Describe your summer vacation (les grandes vacances).

Part 2 - Listening Comprehension:

As you roll over each film, you should see a link for 'bande annonce' which means trailer. Watch the trailer for **5 different movies**, and fill out the following information for **each one**: (Please choose movie trailers that are **in French**.
