World Language Honor Societies

The Spanish Honor Societies is a national organization.

The Spanish honor society was founded by a national organization, the Asociación Americana de Maestros de Español y Portugués with the Pablo Casals chapter at Livingston High School. A student may be admitted during the fourth year of language study of Spanish if he or she received no less than an "A-" as a final grade for College Prep level Spanish 1, 2, or 3 courses as a final grade, or no less than a "B-" as a final grade for Honors level Spanish 2 or 3 courses.

If the student does not meet the above mentioned criteria as a fourth year student, he or she may also be inducted during the fifth year of study provided that the student has maintained an average of B- or higher in an Honors level course or A/A- in a College Prep course.

In addition, the student must maintain a grade of B- in an AP or College Prep level 5 course to enjoy continued membership in the Spanish Honor Societies.

The French Honor Societies is a national organization.

The French honor society was founded by a national organization, the American Association of Teachers of French (AATF). A student may be admitted during the fourth year of language study of French if he or she received no less than an "A-" as a final grade for College Prep level French 1, 2, or 3 courses as a final grade, or no less than a "B-" as a final grade for Honors level French 2 or 3 courses.

If the student does not meet the above mentioned criteria as a fourth year student, he or she may also be inducted during the fifth year of study provided that the student has maintained an average of B- or higher in an Honors level course or A/A- in a College Prep course.

In addition, the student must maintain a grade of B- in an AP or College Prep level 5 course to enjoy continued membership in the French Honor Societies.

The Chinese Honor Society is a national organization.

The Chinese honor society was founded by a national organization, the Chinese Language Association of Secondary-Elementary School (CLASS), with a chapter at Livingston High School. A student who has successfully completed Chinese 2 CP may be admitted into the Chinese Honor Society with a 'B+' or better average. He or she must also be studying the third year of Chinese. A student who has successfully completed 3 CP and 4 CP/Honors may be admitted with a cumulative B- average.

In addition, the student must maintain a grade of B- in an AP or 4 CP/Honors course to enjoy continued membership in the Chinese Honor Societies.

The Italian Honor Society is a national organization.

The Italian honor society was founded by a national organization, La Società Onoraria Italica with the Luigi Pirandello chapter at Livingston High School. A student who has successfully completed Italian 2 CP and Italian 3 CP may be admitted with a cumulative A- average in Italian. A student who has successfully completed Italian 2 CP and Italian 3 Honors may be admitted with a cumulative B+ average in Italian. A student who has successfully completed 2 CP, 3 Honors and 4 CP/Honors may be admitted with a cumulative B- average.
