Robert E. Grady Class of 1975

A top aide in Congress, the Governor's Office and the White House, and a highly successful investment banker and venture capitalist. He has been a close personal advisor to Presidents and Governors over the course of three decades. He is a frequent commentator on public affairs and economic policy in both print and televised media.

Charles Jaffe Class of 1980

A senior columnist for MarketWatch, he writes three weekly columns with an audience of over 20 million readers. He is a f requent guest on NPR and nationally syndicated television news programs. He is the recipient of numerous awards for business journalism and is the author of three books.

Alan Krueger Class of 1979

Bendheim Professor of Economics and Public Policy at Princeton University. Served as Assistant Secretary for Economic Policy, Chief Economist of the U.S. Department of the Treasury in 2009-2010, Chief Economist at the U.S. Department of Labor in 1994-1995. He is an internationally recognized researcher and author and recipient of numerous awards and fellowships.

**Alfred Savia** Class of 1971

An award winning music director who has an internationally respected career as conductor, orchestra builder and teacher. He is a frequent guest conductor throughout North America and around the globe. Under his leadership, he has expanded the Evansville Philharmonic to include youth and family programming.

Joanne Silberner Class of 1973

Artist-in-Residence at the University of Washington, she has served as a health policy correspondent for NPR for 18 years. She has a special focus on medical and health policy issues, mental health, FDA, Medicare, and international health and neglected diseases. She has also worked for U.S. News and World Report and Science News.


