Dear RHE Families:

I hope that you have all enjoyed your summer vacation thus far and are looking forward to an exciting and engaging 2018-2019 school year! Please read below to learn more about the many changes that occurred at RHE this summer.

Over the summer, our custodians and the maintenance and custodial team have been hard at work getting all of the classrooms ready for students. The building looks fantastic, and we are so grateful for their hard work! Many of our classrooms have been painted and our hallways are sparkling clean. The black top area has been resurfaced and will be freshly painted with hopscotch and foursquare stencils to provide more recess options. The lower basketball area will be resurfaced soon. Additionally, thank you to the RHE HSA for purchasing a Gaga Pit for all students to use, which should shortly arrive at our school!

Our new school nurse, Mrs. Giordano, will be available to discuss any medical needs for your child(ren) and to collect medications on Wednesday, August 29th from 9 to 10 am, and Thursday, August 30th from 1 to 2 pm.

Mindfulness and Character Education:

This year, RHE will focus on a mindfulness initiative, while also infusing a large amount of character education experiences and lessons through community meetings. Through read alouds and affiliated lessons, we will be addressing kindness through the lens of Lester Laminack's book, <u>Bullying Hurts</u>. Additionally, we will have a particular focus on the concept of "growth mindset." Our teachers will all be reading, <u>The Growth Mindset Coach</u>: A Teacher's Month-by-Month Handbook for Empowering Students to <u>Achieve</u> by Annie Brock and Heather Hundley in an ongoing effort to promote "The Power of Yet." We look forward to working with our students regarding this concept.

Fifth Grade Rotation Schedule:

Fifth grade students will rotate between three homeroom teachers to receive their instruction each day. Mr. Arensburg will teach science and social studies, Mrs. Corino will teach reading and writing, and Mrs. Kelly will teach mathematics, calendar math, and word study.

Lunch and Recess:

This year, we will have three separate lunch periods to reduce the number of students in the cafeteria and playground/recess areas at the same time. All students will remain in the cafeteria for a full 30 minutes. In addition to reducing the number of students at recess at one time, this new lunch and recess rotation will encourage students to eat a healthy lunch, foster communication skills with their peers, in addition to providing an age appropriate recess.
