Each day we are hosting *Meet & Greet* Sessions, teachers will conclude period 4 and 5 classes no later than 1:30 p.m. to allow for travel time to the *Meet & Greet*.

Please review the instructions and details about our *Meet & Greet* sessions to properly prepare for your visit to MPM:

- All students should bring a beach towel, yoga mat, or blanket to sit on while visiting. We will be using the open field behind MPM to host our sessions.
- Upon arrival, students should exit their vehicle, wearing a face mask. When they approach the admission area they will check in and have their temperature screened. Masks must be worn at all times during the visit to MPM.

- Students will be grouped according to homeroom and directed to sit socially distanced in designated areas.
- Our team of teachers and grade level school counselors will then meet with the students to introduce themselves, go over some expectations for the school year and most importantly give students the opportunity to socialize with their peers.
- At the end of the Meet and Greet, students will line up to prepare for departure. If any teachers have materials to provide to the students it will be done at that time. Additionally, if your child has not received a planner we will have them available for distribution.

Parking is limited. Parents, if you choose to wait while your child is attending the *Meet & Greet*, please find parking on a local side street. The MPM parking lot is designated for the MPM faculty and staff.
