Dear LHS Students and Parents,

This morning Collegeboard released information regarding the administration of 2019-2020 AP Exams. Below are the highlights:

- For the 19-20 academic year, there will be *no traditional*, *in-person exams*. Instead, students will be offered to take a 45 minute online, at home exam.
- Collegeboard will provide free, remote learning resources to students.
- Students will be offered two different testing windows to choose from for each subject.
- Students who choose to cancel their exam will *not* be charged a cancelation fee. I encourage students to wait to make this decision until more information regarding the exams is available. Collegeboard has already released that exams will only include topics and skills most AP teachers and students have already covered in class by early March.
- Colleges support this solution and are committed to ensuring that AP students receive the credit they have worked to earn.
- More information, including the new exam schedule, specific free response question types and additional information will be available on April 3.
