Dear Students and Parents,


We are already beginning to plan for the 2023 – 2024 scheduling process! Many of you are starting to discuss course selection for next year with your child. While we recognize that the 2023-2024 LHS Course Guide has not yet been shared with you, please know that this packet is intended to provide you with information with advanced notice for your planning purposes. With that, it is important to know that several of our <u>Advanced Placement (AP)</u> courses have applications that are <u>required</u> to qualify for open access into these programs. Additionally, several <u>Honors</u> courses offer applications to indicate readiness and provide students and parents with important recommendation information to consider when making course selections. Please review this <u>condensed list</u> of these courses that **require** an application. Please note that <u>not</u> all AP and Honors courses require an application. Only those listed in this packet require prerequisite applications.

All AP course applications are due <u>January 30, 2023 by 8:00 a.m</u>. Any student who does not submit an application for a course by this deadline will be placed on a waitlist. Completion of an application and/or placement on a waitlist <u>does not</u> guarantee enrollment in the course. Please review the scheduling timeline below to ensure that you are meeting all necessary deadlines.

Applications for these courses take place **before** students make course selections so that recommendations can be made in advance of scheduling meetings with school counselors. Should your child be interested in any of these courses that require an application, or have any interest in exploring any of these courses, we highly recommend they complete the application to leave their options open during their scheduling meeting. If you have any questions about a course requiring a qualifying assessment or application, please reach out to your school counselor prior to these deadlines.

February 8	Teacher recommendations are posted in Genesis.
February 10 – March 31	Individual student scheduling meetings with school counselors.
April 1 - April 13 (Including Spring Break)	Course Verification: Student/parent deadline to confirm course selections in Genesis and to request any change prior to master schedule construction.
June 19 - June 22	Course lists for 2023-2024 schedules posted in Genesis. Students/parents must sign and acknowledge that they have viewed this course confirmation list.
June 23 – August 10	Summer schedule change window.
August 10	Deadline to request schedule changes by 3:00 p.m.
Late August	Student schedules posted in Genesis.
