

# Goals & Background of Senior Internship Program (SIP)

- Goal: Students identify interests, gain work experience, and apply knowledge and skills acquired in high school
- Goal: Foster networking and career opportunities that will have a positive future impact
- SIP is part of NJ Structured Learning Experience
  - Mrs. Wohltmann is certified as coordinator of this program along with other LHS faculty
- Other local high schools offer programs
  - 2020 1st year of program\*



## Senior Internship Program Overview

- Students pursue an unpaid internship in an area of interest such as professional, academic, athletic/sports, community, or agency groups
- Internship is opportunity for students to gain real-world experience while applying course knowledge in structured environment
  - Put into practice what they have learned at LHS
- Program is open to ALL seniors in good academic standing, on track to graduate in June 2021
- Internship Program Dates are May 24-June 18, 2021
- 20 hours per week, minimum 80 hours total
  - Schedule is coordinated based on need of internship site



## 2021 Senior Internship Program Plan

- Students are responsible for securing their internships
  - Start now!
- Application process & approval required
- Internships may be on-site, hybrid, or remote
  - If physical/hybrid-there is a 20 minute driving limit from LHS
  - Site must follow all safety/COVID-19 precautions
  - If hybrid/remote-student advised to meet with Mrs.
     Wohltmann prior to submitting application to detail how internship will work





## Types of Internships

- Students pursue an unpaid internship in an area of interest such as professional, academic, athletic/sports, community, or agency groups
- Decide what your area of interest is, and begin to research, contact & network
- Plan to offer December/January "Virtual Open House/Match Night" for interested students and internships
- Mrs. Wohltmann is available for student meetings throughout this entire process to answer questions and offer guidance
- Now is the time to begin your research





## Application, Process, Deadlines

- Application will be on <u>SIP website</u>
- Application to be initiated by student
  - Application then sent electronically to Parent, Mentor, and Internship Coordinator
  - All components of the application due Friday, February 26, 2021
- Once completed, the application is reviewed and a site visit will be conducted (in-person or virtual)
- Application approved/declined
- Students that are approved will be required to attend
   Internship Orientation Sessions








- Students are responsible for securing their internships of interest
- All internships are open for consideration\*
  - Except those deemed unsafe, hazardous
  - Need to meet 2 Standards from the NJ 9.3 Career & Technical Content Standards
  - In-person/hybrid internship-20 minute driving limit from LHS
- Student complete attendance and weekly journal assignments
- Multimedia Presentation (Senior Showcase)
- 1 credit earned upon completion of Internship Program


