

Domino Math Facts: Teacher Preparation

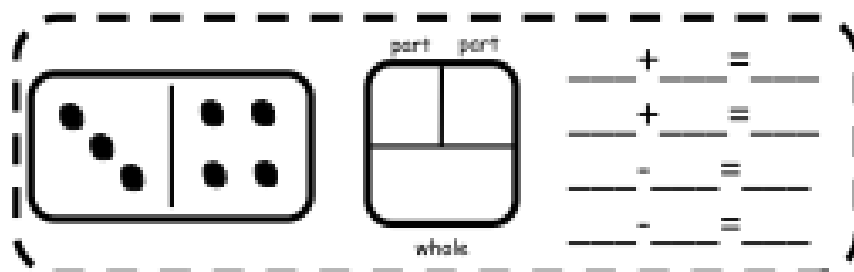
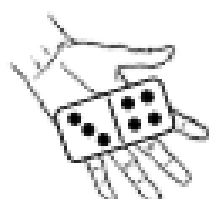

Domino Math Facts: Student Directions

- 1) Pick a domino.
- 2) Draw the domino's dots.
- 3) Write the quantity of dots in each part as well as the whole domino.
- 4) Write the addition problems that can be made by adding the two parts of the domino.
- 5) Write the subtraction problems that can be made by subtracting the dots in one part of the domino from the dots on the whole domino.

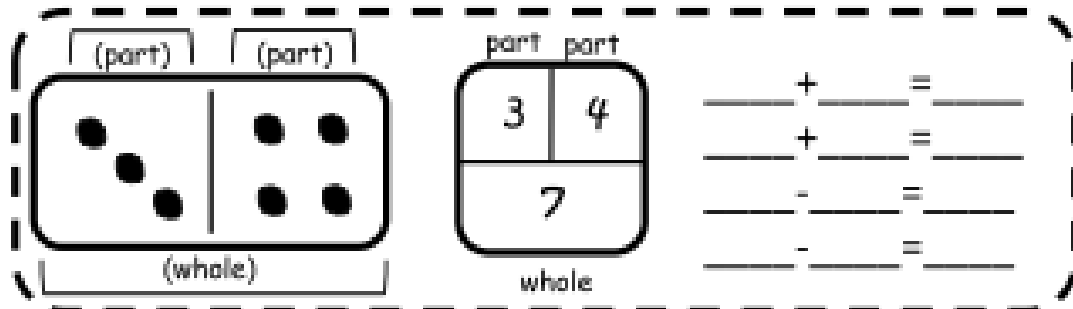
