## FIELD TRIP/WALKING TRIP MEDICATION SUSPENSION FORM

Due to a revision in New Jersey state law, teachers, other parents or chaperones <u>may not</u> administer medication to children on field trips. Only a nurse or relative may do so. Hence, as of September 1, 1999, any child whose physician has prescribed daily medication during school hours must have a parent or relative accompany him/her on a field trip to administer medication. If a parent or relative is unable to accompany the child and a nurse is not available, a <u>physician's authorization</u> will be needed to suspend medication for a field trip.
