Draw a winding path and fill the spaces with math equations. Kids roll the dice and move from space to space (have them jump, skip, or twirl to mix things up). If they get the answer right, they move to the new space. If not, their turn is over.	15 - 4 16 - 4 learning
Grab your UNO deck and get ready to move! Assign each color a movement (Examples: Red – Hop, Yellow – Stomp, Green – Twirl, Blue - Touch Elbows to Opposite Knees). As kids draw the cards, everyone completes the movement the correct number of times. Skip and Reverse work as usual, but anyone who gets Draw Two has to draw two more cards, and complete the actions on their own while others cheer them on.
