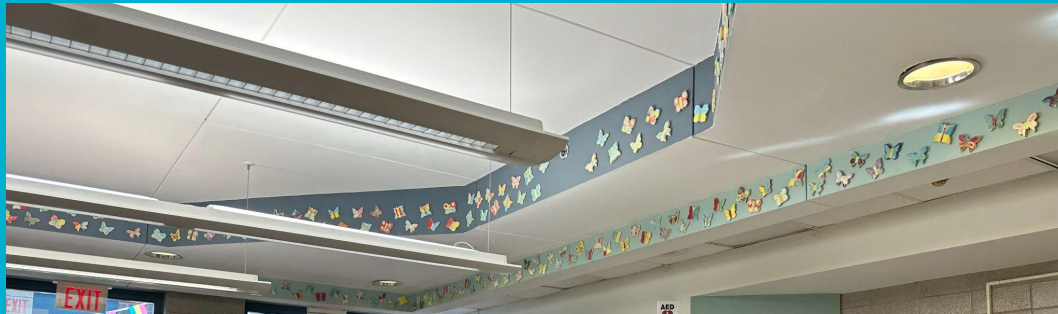
The Butterflies

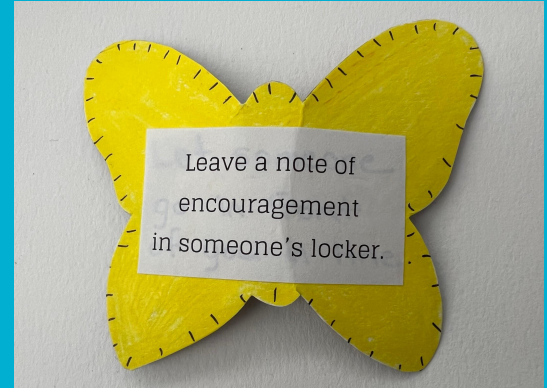


The Transformation – First Days of School

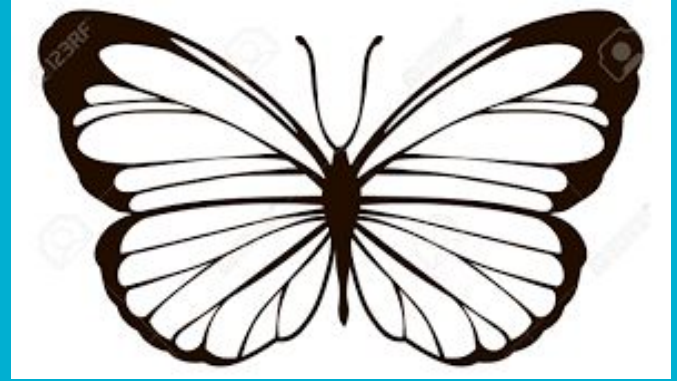

- We created Butterfly Identity Webs. We colored the sections of our butterflies with different colors that represent our identities.





Advisory Lesson 2: Acts of Kindness
