Apple Sum Game

Skills Overview

- Students will practice finding pairs of numbers that add up to 10.

Number of Players

- 2 or 3

Material

- Game board
- Crayons (Different color for each player)

How to play

- Each player chooses a different color crayon.
- Players take turns finding and coloring pairs of adjacent squares that have a sum of 10.
(For example, player 1 may color two joining shapes that have the numbers 9 and 1. Then player 2 may color joining shapes with the numbers 6 and 4.)

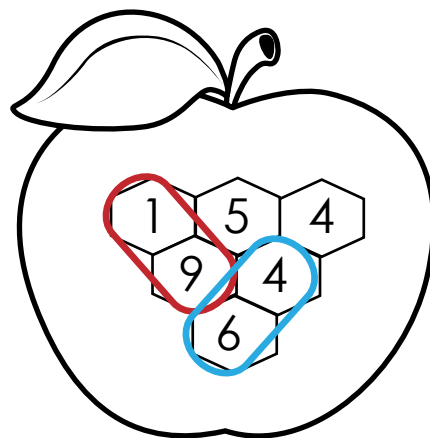
Management suggestions

- You may want to limit the amount of time a player is given to find a pair of numbers. (For example, if a player can't find a matching pair in 20 seconds, they lose their turn.)

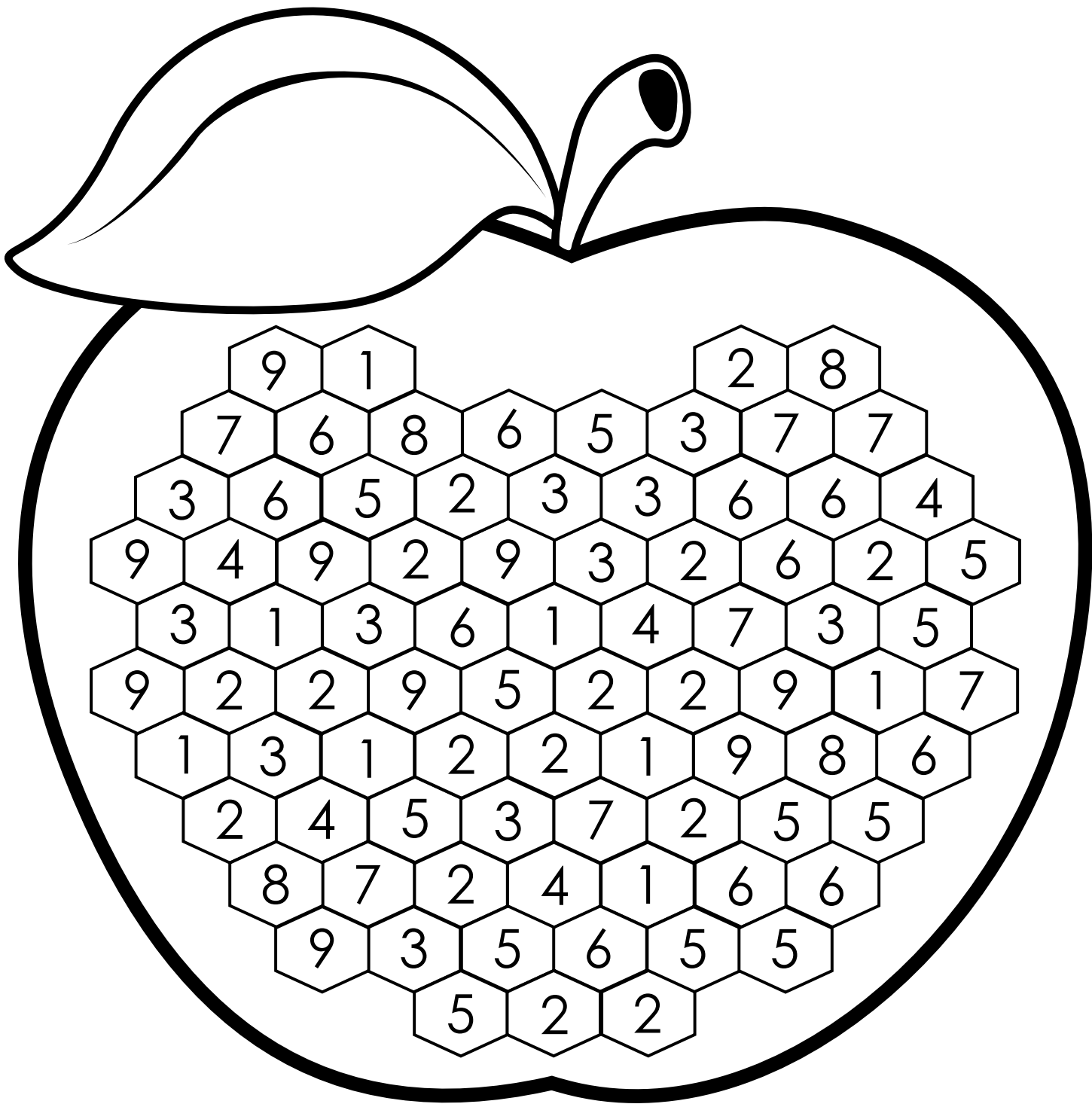

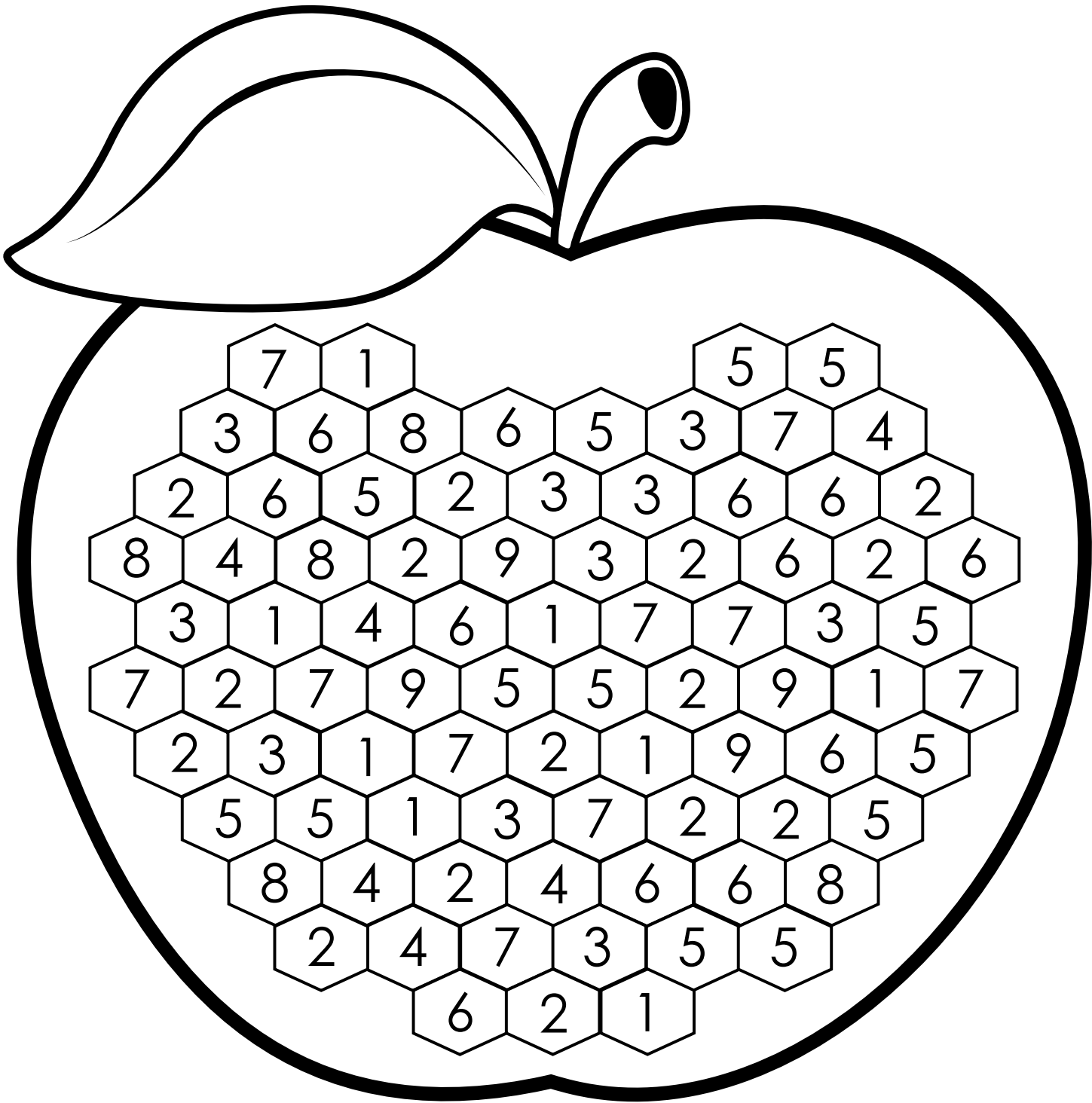

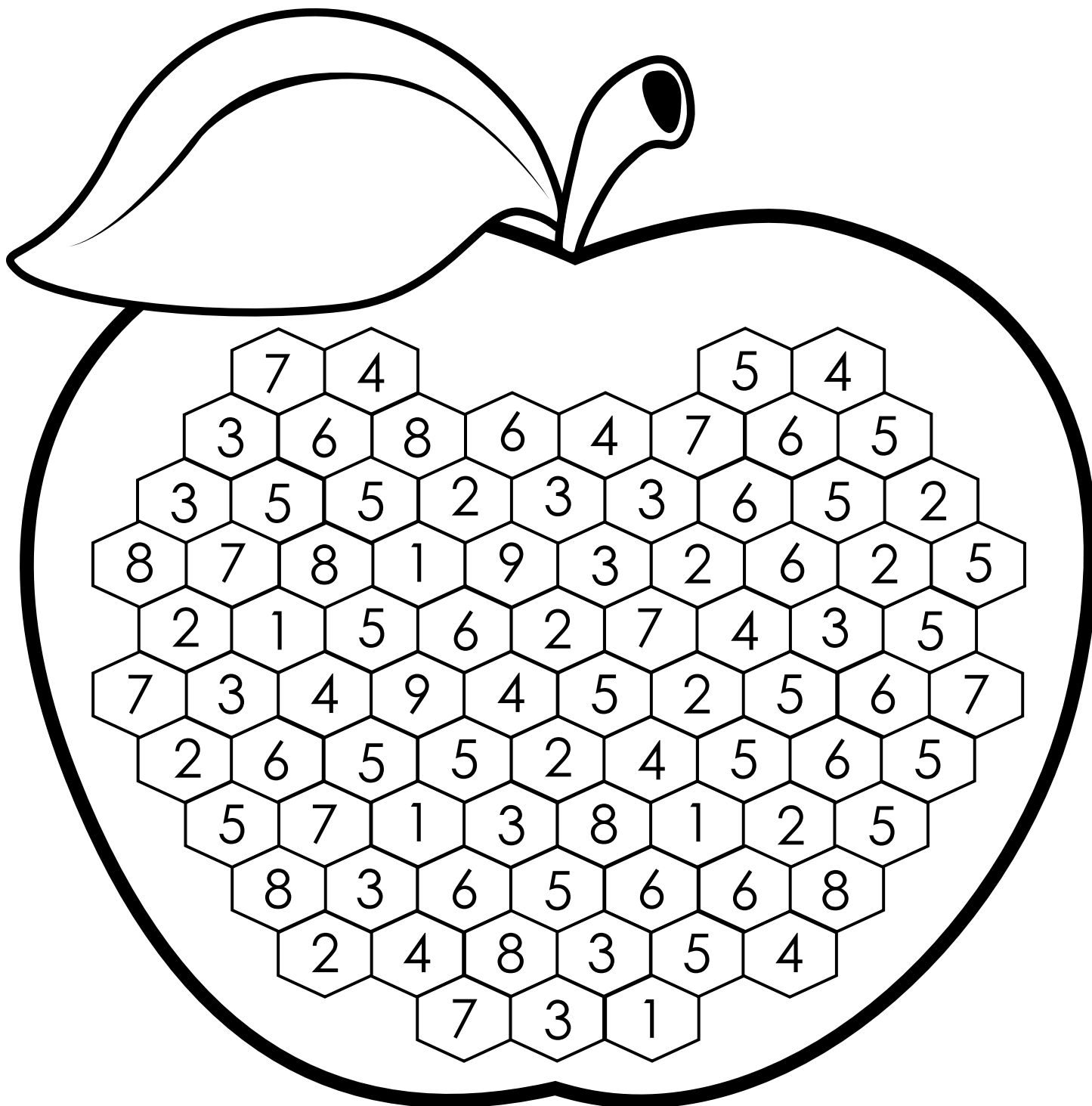
