

Staffing Additions

At Livingston Public Schools, 73 percent of the professional staff hold Master's degrees and 5 percent of the staff have received their Doctorates.

Proposed in Draft Budget

- (2) FTE teachers at HMS to reduce current class sizes with similar number of students (allocations & departments TBD)
- (4) FTE teachers at LHS to maintain class sizes with increasing population (allocations & departments TBD)
- (1) full-time District Nurse, primarily used at LHS & HMS, with flexibility to assist throughout the District
- (1) full-time Basic Skills Instruction (BSI) teacher to support math instruction at Elementary Schools (currently 2 for 6 schools; will be 3 for 6 schools)
- (1) full-time Teacher of Students with Disabilities for the Life Skills program at HMS
- (.4) Teacher of Students with Disabilities at MPMS to reduce student/teacher ratio
- \$20K allocated towards security personnel to cover evening and weekend events as needed within District



Staffing Adjustments

- Reduction of (1) MPMS Assistant Principal position
 - Through repositioning of supervisory offices in buildings, the school is sufficiently supported with one administrator
 - Student population is less than some elementary schools and will continue to decrease in size over the course of the next few years
- Reduction of (1) Elementary School Teacher position
 - Decline in enrollment
 - Will occur through attrition
