

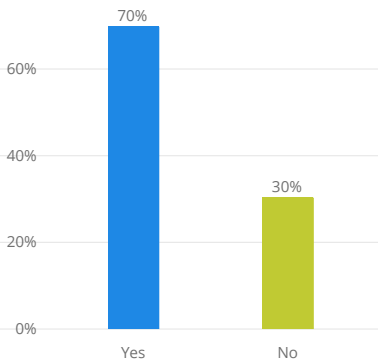


Livingston Public Schools - Return to School - Parent Survey - July 2020

If schools reopen for full, in-person, instruction with appropriate safety measures, do you intend to have your child return to school in person in September 2020? 4,182 Responses

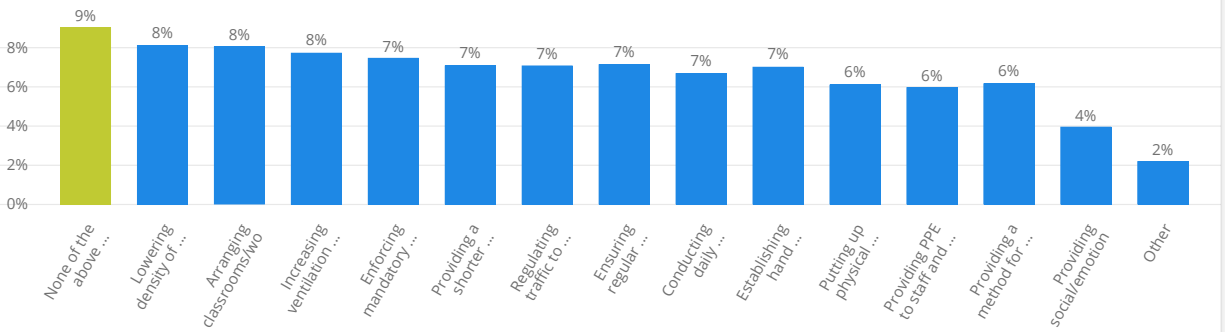

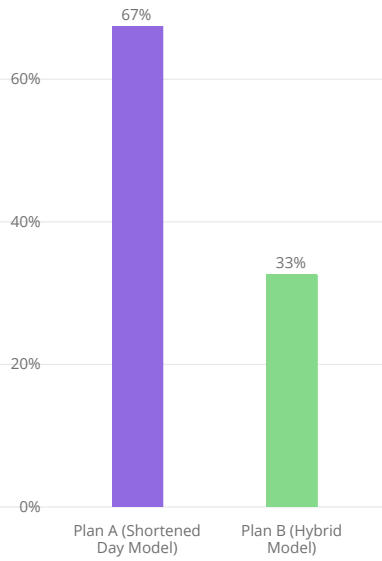

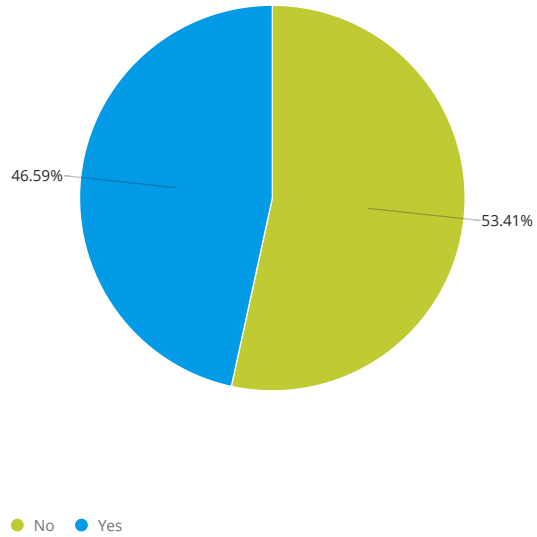


"YES" Pathway - Elementary - Based on the information provided by Dr. Block in his letter of July 17, 2020, I would prefer that my child attend school using the following model:

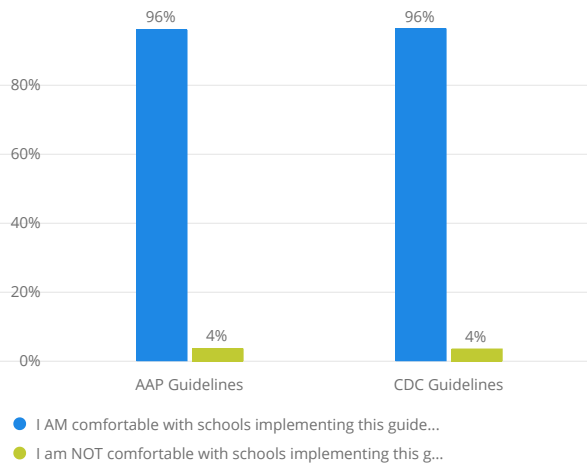
