Have a "book talk" about your favorite part. Visualize the setting of your book. Draw a picture describing details of the setting on the back of this paper. Be sure to color! Read and use one <u>reading strategy</u> that helps you with your current <u>reading goal</u> (ex: fluency, Stop and Jot, context clues). 	<p>On Tuesdays, "Stop and Jot" as you read.
