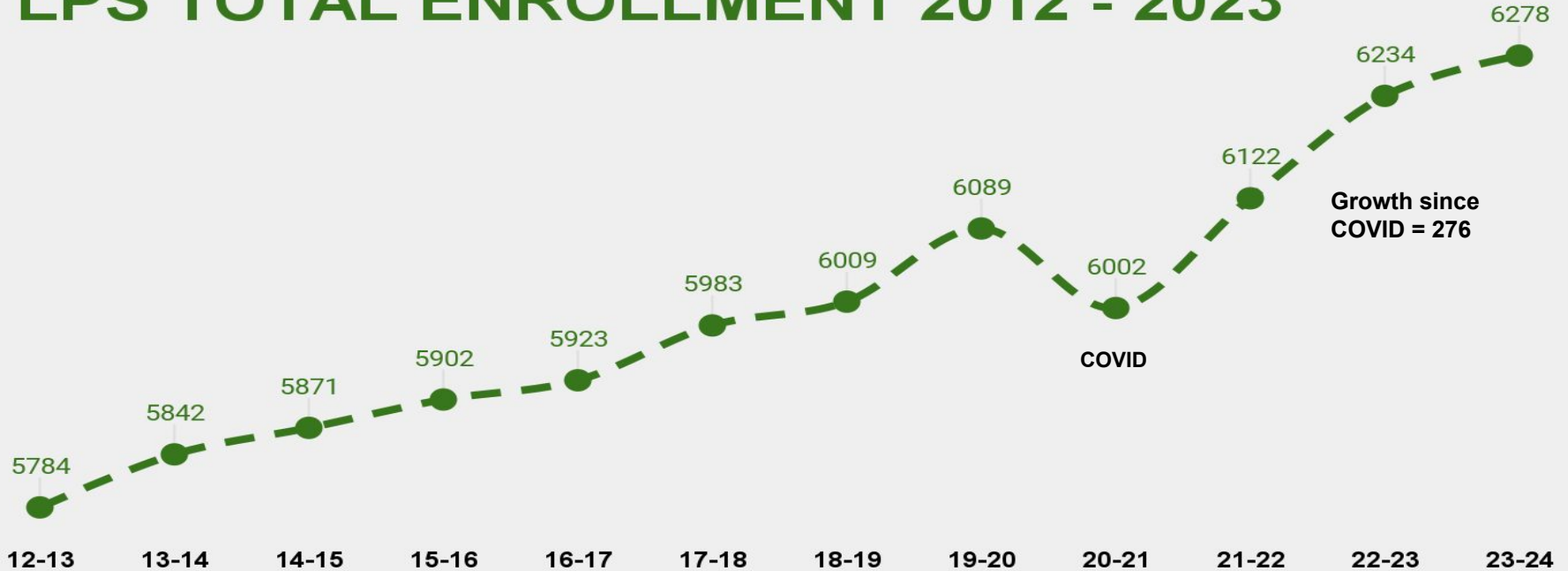

# LPS TOTAL ENROLLMENT 2012 - 2023

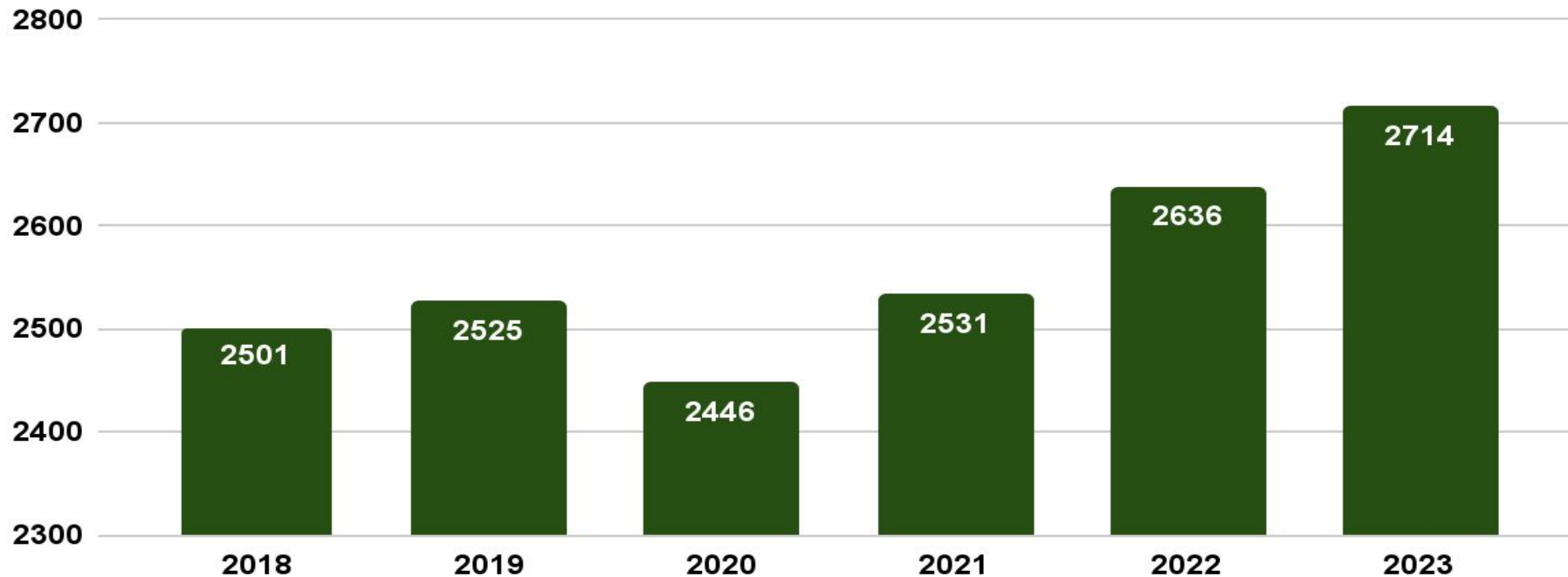


- Total increase over the first six years (2012-2017) = 199
- Total increase over the second six years (2018-2023) = 269
- Total increase since 2012 to present = 494
- Since 2020, the Board supported the addition of 10 new elementary sections to support growth & smaller class sizes.

## Secondary Enrollment

While secondary enrollment has grown over the past three years, there are no major changes so far this summer.

- Mt. Pleasant Middle School: 489 from 486 (+3)
- Heritage Middle School: 1001 from 1003 (-2)
- Livingston High School: 2071 from 2068 (+3)

### **OVERALL**

A increase of 4 students from 2022-2023 to 2023-2024 at the secondary level.
